In Grades 11–12, students have the opportunity to choose between the IB Diploma Programme or ISZL High School Programme. Around 60% of our students complete the IB Diploma Programme, while 40% complete the High School/ AP Programme.

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate from ISZL, students must demonstrate satisfactory completion of the IB Middle Years Programme and subsequent satisfactory completion of the IB Diploma Programme, or the ISZL High School Programme, including a minimum of:

- Ten courses over Grades 11 and 12
- · Six courses in both Grades 9 and 10
- Four years: Service Project(s)
- Three years: English and Humanities and Science and Mathematics (at least one year in Grade 11 or 12)
- · Two years: Language Acquisition
- Two years: Arts or Design or Physical and Health Education

CLASS OF 2024

The Class of 2024 has 116 students. The High School enrolment is 475 students, with approximately 120 students per grade level.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The PDP is a mandatory component of the ISZL pastoral curriculum. The PDP is made up of three school-wide elements – Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE), Service Projects and a Personal Development Week – that engages students in their development as well-rounded individuals.

PSHE

PSHE explores a wide range of topics including healthy relationships, healthy minds and healthy bodies, decision making, life skills, mindfulness, sex education, social media, college counselling support, leadership, academic honesty and child protection.

PRINCIPLED INNOVATIONS PROGRAMME (PIP)

PIP is designed to provide learning experiences that will help Grade 9 and 10 students to live ISZL's mission, vision and values. The PIP programme focuses on teaching students to deepen a personal understanding of their identities, core values and motivations, consider how they as individuals interact with and contribute to the community, and develop an orientation towards principled and sustainable action.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT WEEK (PDW)

The Personal Development Week (PDW) programme challenges our students to engage in service and to expand their horizons. Held at locations around Europe and the wider world, the PDW allows students to continue their learning in a real-world context. In the words of our school vision, they are encouraged to turn their learning into action. ISZL partners with community organisations to ensure the work done on PDWs makes a long-lasting impact. Projects are centred around the UN Sustainable Development Goals. They link to the IB DP CAS (Creativity, Activity and Service) programme, the ISZL High School service programme and Service as Action in the IB Middle Years Programme.

SOCIAL ENTERPRISE, ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND SERVICE

The SEES programme incorporates the IB Middle Years Programme Service as Action and the IB Diploma Programme's CAS (Creativity, Activity & Service). The programme challenges students to identify needs and problems, to bring subject-specific skills to real world contexts and to collaborate and innovate in order to become part of the solution.

The completion of a range of SEES-related activities is a core requirement of all of our High School programmes:

- Grade 9/10 MYP students need to meet the Service as Action learner outcomes.
- Grade 11/12 IBDP/High School students need to meet CAS/ Service requirements.
